Purpose & Intended Audience

- Parts 2 & 3: skills practice and testing by a PALS Instructor at Blank Children's Hospital.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

FOR PART 1

- Go to the American Heart Association website at onlineaha.org (this program is PC & Mac compatible).
- Find the course titled HeartCode® PALS Part 1 and click on "Add to Cart."
- Complete the online registration & pay by credit card.
- Complete the PALS Course online, including achieving a score of 84% or higher on the course exam (Access to this program will be available for 24 months from the initial license activation).
- Print the HeartCode® Certificate of Completion and bring to the skills testing.

FOR PARTS 2 & 3

- Go to the Blank Children's Hospital website at blankchildrens.org/classes and click on Continuing Education.
- Find the course titled Heartcode PALS.
- Register for your CPR and PALS Skills evaluation.
- A PALS Provider card will be issued after the successful completion of the Part 2 & 3 skills portion.
