Thank you for your interest in the Volunteen Program at Iowa Lutheran Hospital! Volunteens help one regular day a week, Monday through Thursday, from 4:00 to 6 p.m. Volunteens serve patients and assist staff at Iowa Lutheran Hospital by visiting with patients, delivering cards and flowers, stocking supplies and much more. As a Volunteen, you will help the community, gain knowledge of healthcare careers, have the opportunity to develop leadership skills, make new friends, and have fun!

To become a Volunteen, you must meet the following requirements:

- Be between the ages of 14-18 years of age
- Return your completed application including a parent/guardian signature and two reference forms
- References must be adults not related to you with knowledge of your capabilities
- Complete a free health screening at the hospital
- Receive the once a year flu vaccination (mist or vaccine)
- Purchase your uniform shirt from the Volunteer Services Department
- Be able to have transportation to come to volunteer
- Be able to commit to at least 75 % attendance through the year
- Be able to commit to the program for at least 6 months

Once we receive your application, references, and grade release authorization we will contact you to set up a date and time for an interview.
