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- Special considerations**
    - Ensure safety of scene and surrounding area. Notify local haz-mat team.
    - Wear appropriate personal protective equipment.
    - Wear dosimeter if available.
    - Notify receiving facility to prepare for a patient who is contaminated.
    - If burns are present, treat per Burn Protocol
    - Notify EMS System of radiation incident as soon as possible.
- NOTE: Notify local Emergency Management Agency of radiation incident.**
