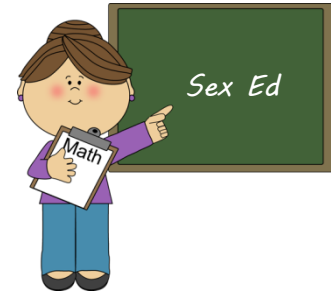


What's Where On The Web For Teachers?
