

Fire Safety House Terms and Conditions

Please be advised of the following terms and conditions for using the Blank Children's Hospital Fire Safety House:

1. Please remember that your reservation form is a request, and all use depends upon the availability of the Fire Safety House and its staff.
2. Fire Safety House staff will bring the House to your location, set it up, and train your volunteers.
3. The Fire Safety House is an educational tool, and must be adequately staffed. We recommend a **minimum of 5-7 volunteers per four hour shift**. It is the responsibility of the hosting fire department or community group to provide volunteers.
4. Please allow adequate room for the Fire Safety House trailer (38 ft. long; 8 ft. wide; 12 ft. high) plus the tow vehicle.
5. The Fire Safety House is not recommended for children under 5 years of age.
6. The Fire Safety House runs on its own generator. We will let you know if you need to provide a 110 volt electrical hookup with 30 amp service.
7. Every child under age 18 must have a signed consent form prior to touring the Fire Safety House.
8. Allow 20 – 30 minutes for each group of 6 – 8 children.
9. In order to prevent falls, there must be a volunteer to staff the fire escape ladder at all times during your event. Only one person is to be on the fire escape ladder at any time.
10. The hosting fire department and/or community organization is responsible for any damage to the Fire Safety House incurred during its visit to your location.
11. In **EXTREMELY RARE** instances, mild transient eye irritations could occur due to theatrical smoke. In this instance, flush the eye with water for 15 minutes, lifting the upper and lower lids during flushing to ensure complete removal of the chemical. If irritation persists, seek medical attention.
