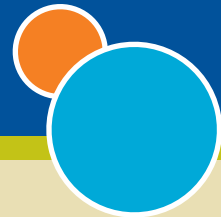

Requirements

You will need proof of:

- Current Iowa RN license
- Current CPR certification
- TB skin test within the last 12 months
- Tdap within the past 10 years
- Two MMR vaccinations if you were born in 1957 or after
- Chicken pox status - immunization or proof of immunity
- Influenza vaccine
- A copy of your mandatory reporter certificate
- A criminal background check completed within the previous 12 months
- A current PALS or ENPC certification (for the Pediatric ED)
- A current NRP certification (for the NICU and OB)
