Requirements

You will need to show:

- A copy of your current RN license
- A copy of your current CPR certification
- A copy of your TB skin test within the last 12 months
- Proof of two MMR vaccinations if you were born in 1957 or after
- Proof of chicken pox status
- Influenza vaccine
- A copy of your mandatory reporter certificate
- A current PALS certification (for the Pediatric ED)
- A current NRP certification (for the NICU and OB)
