Purpose: The purpose of Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) is to help all course participants succeed in acquiring the skills and knowledge they need for their professional role in resuscitation attempts.

Continuing Education: IBON Provider No. 46 awards 7.5 contact hours for the initial ACLS class and 4.0 contact hours for the Renewal class. (Only one similar course title may be used during your license renewal period.)

Faculty: Medical Director for St. Luke's ACLS Program: Dr. Dustin Arnold. Molly Eilers BSN, RN. St. Luke's certified ACLS instructors who are professional nurses, paramedics and respiratory therapists active in all areas of adult critical care and education.

Target Audience: Registered nurses and other interested healthcare professionals

Cost: All Participants: \$100 for provider course (includes textbook); \$50 for renewal course. *Free to STL associates who are required to have ACLS for their position. If requesting contact hours for continuing education, your fee will be \$10 for the initial class or \$5 for the renewal class.

Textbooks: ACLS textbooks may be purchased in Staff Development for \$40 or checked out on a first come, first served basis.

Pre-requisite: Participants must have taken a Basic Dysrhythmia course prior to class. Rhythm strips are shown in ACLS, and without prior knowledge of how rhythms look, it is hard to pass the course.

Objectives:

The Advanced Cardiac Life Support educational objectives include:

1. Perform an evaluation and manage the first ten minutes of a witnessed, adult, ventricular fibrillation cardiac arrest.
2. Perform the primary "ABCD" Survey of the cardiac patient including: early access, early CPR, airway management, use of the automatic external defibrillator and conventional defibrillator.
3. Perform secondary "ABCD" survey of the cardiac patient including: more definitive skills in airway, breathing and circulation with endotracheal intubation, proper ventilation techniques, initiation of IV, use of pharmacological agents, recognition of arrhythmias and the use of resuscitation algorithms in cardiac arrest management.
4. Describe patient management in the post-resuscitation period.
5. Participate in the assessment and team management of nine cases of ACLS: Respiratory Arrest, Pulseless Ventricular Fibrillation/Tachycardia with AED Ventricular Fibrillation/Tachycardia Refractory to Initial Defibrillation, Pulseless Electrical Activity, Asystole, Acute Myocardial Infarction, Bradycardia, Stable Tachycardia and Unstable Tachycardia.
6. Integrate the AED with adult CPR skills.
