Purpose: The purpose of this program is to give information needed to recognize the infant or child at risk of cardiac or respiratory arrest and prevent, if possible. The program also provides cognitive and psychomotor skills necessary for resuscitation and stabilizing the infant in respiratory failure, shock or arrest.

Continuing Education: IBON Provider No. 46 awards 8 contact hours for the initial PALS class and 3.75 contact hours for the Renewal class. (Only one similar course title may be used during your license renewal period.)

1. Recognize the two most common pre-arrest syndromes and describe interventions to prevent cardiopulmonary arrest in the pediatric patient.
2. Demonstrate the use of adjuncts for airway and mechanical breathing.
3. Demonstrate and prioritize various vascular access techniques, including intraosseous cannulation.
4. Discuss the indicators for emergency treatment of rhythm disturbances in children.
5. Develop priorities for the management of shock, respiratory failure and cardio-pulmonary arrest.
