## EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

Call 911 and come to an emergency department immediately for **serious or life-threatening medical problems.**

**UnityPoint Health® – St. Luke's Hospital is open 24 hours, every day and night of the year.**

### Emergency conditions include:

- chest pain
- severe abdominal pain
- coughing or vomiting blood
- deep cuts or bleeding that won't stop
- sudden blurred vision
- numbness in face or limbs
- severe burns
- difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- sudden dizziness, weakness, loss of coordination or balance
- sudden, severe headache
- seizures

## URGENT CARE CLINIC



When your primary care provider is not available, urgent care clinics offer care for **non-life-threatening medical problems or conditions that could get worse if you wait.**

**UnityPoint Clinic® Urgent Care and Express is open every day, including holidays.**

**You should go to an urgent care clinic for common illnesses such as:**

- colds
- flu
- ear aches
- sore throats
- migraines
- fever
- rashes

**Minor injuries such as:**

- sprains
- back pain

- minor broken bones
- minor eye injuries
