HOME CRISIS PLAN**

If you feel your child is at risk of harming him/herself or others while at home you should follow these steps:

- If during our normal operating hours you may call the program staff for help or advice on how to proceed.
- If the crisis occurs before or after program hours you may call the Juvenile and Family Assistance and Stabilization Track (J-FAST) at 319-362-2174.
- If you feel there is an imminent safety risk, you may take your child to St. Luke's Emergency Department for an evaluation to determine if they need to be admitted to our inpatient Child/Adolescent Unit.
 - If you need assistance transporting your child, because of a safety concern, you may contact the police department for assistance.

This plan is also outlined for you in the yellow "Frequently Asked Questions" handout you received at intake. You should have also received a flyer outlining the J-FAST program.
