

## **ACP Clinical Vignette Competition**

- Purpose: To promote resident involvement in scholarship efforts through presenting a particularly interesting patient with significant teaching value.
- Method: A clinical patient vignette is briefly discussed and then a review of the pertinent medical literature about this entity is undertaken. A ten minute slide presentation is the required format with five minutes then available for questions.
- When: Held yearly.
- Where: An intramural competition will be held annually at Iowa Methodist Medical Center. Selected faculty will judge the competition, and winners will be chosen to represent our Program and compete with residents from the University of Iowa at the state chapter meeting of the ACP.
- Who: Competition is open to all internal medicine residents. Each resident is required to present at least one ACP clinical vignette during his or her residency.
