

Jeopardy Schedule

- Basic Rules
 - Coverage will remain within a class except under extreme circumstances (R3s cover R3s, etc.)
 - Coverage time for each resident will be recorded in an attempt to maintain balance and fairness among the residents.
 - Attempts will be made to avoid missing COC time for Jeopardy coverage.
 - Institution of jeopardy coverage will be determined by PD, CMR and/or Staff/Attending Physician. (Potentially not necessary for only ½ to 1 day absence).
 - During any one rotation, a resident will provide no greater than 1 week of coverage in order to avoid not completing their originally assigned rotation.
 - Residents on away/audition rotations will not be available for coverage.
 - Residents with previously approved and scheduled vacation time will not be expected to cover.

- R1 Coverage
 - Rotations Requiring Coverage
 - All weekend call shifts
 - Night medicine
 - Ward Rotations: ICU, Y7, BMC, VA, Y8 Pulm
 - Rotations Available to Provide Coverage
 - Coverage may be provided by senior resident on these services as determined by PD, CMR and attending in discussion with senior resident
 - Elective
 - TY/Prelim on elective
 - Gastroenterology
 - Endocrine
 - Ambulatory Cardiology
