

Medical Meeting Policy

1. The residency program allows second and third year residents to attend up to one local, regional or national medical meeting of their choice each year. Meetings must be approved by the Program Director. Expenses to attend these meetings may be drawn from the \$600 per year educational allotment (\$1800 during three years training) granted to each resident.
2. Maximum time of 5 days per year for a meeting for a second and third year resident. Additional time may **not** be carried over to the third year if it is not used during the second year.
3. Meeting time cannot be taken on inpatient rotations and the resident must arrange call coverage for any assigned call days during this absence.
4. Continuity of care Clinics must be notified at least one month in advance.
5. Location of medical meetings/board reviews must be in the continental United States.
