

Nurse Residency Home Care Track

Overview

Nurse Residents are oriented into the Visit Nurse role during the first 12 weeks of employment, with a year-long orientation and transition into the Nurse Case Manager role. Orientation includes completion of several educational offerings, including Negative Pressure Wound Therapy, Wound Assessment/Wound Treatment, Ostomy Basics, PICCs/Ports/Pumps, Prevention/Treatment/Management of Lower Extremity Ulcers, Person-Centered Care, and other required online learning modules. The program combines didactic classroom time with knowledge assessments and hands-on skill demonstration.

Residents work closely with a dedicated preceptor and an interdisciplinary team, planning and providing skilled care, to individuals in their homes. Critical thinking skills are enriched through home care sim labs, monthly residency seminars, and completion of an evidence-based project.
