As a UnityPoint Health Finley Hospital Volunteer, there are specific requirements we need to complete prior to your start date. Your Volunteer Health Screening should be at least 3 days prior to your start date.

As a Volunteer you have the option to sign a release of information for Finley Occupational Health to obtain a copy of your Annual Physical Completed within 12 months of start date.

If this form is not completed prior to this appointment, you will be asked to complete it at that time. We have a limited amount of time for your appointment; if we are not able to complete your Screening, you may need to be rescheduled.

As a condition of employment with UnityPoint Health Finley Hospital, Volunteers are required to provide PROOF of the following:

- Recent Influenza Vaccination
- Negative TB Test (2-step or T Spot) within 1 year of start date
 - If you have a history of a Positive TB Test, then please provide your MOST RECENT Chest X-ray.
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) Vaccination **OR**
 - Tetanus (Td) Vaccination
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) Vaccination **OR**
 - History of Chicken Pox Disease -- Age: _____
 - Varicella Titer
- Hepatitis B Vaccinations (3 doses) – *Volunteers may decline this vaccine.*
 - Hep B Antibody Titer
- MMR Vaccinations (2 doses) **OR**
 - Measles (Rubeola or HARD Measles) Immunization
 - Measles Titer
 - Mumps Immunization
 - Mumps Titer
 - Rubella (German Measles) Immunization
 - Rubella Titer
- Covid Vaccine

If you are not able to provide proof of vaccinations, we will order Titers and/or administer Vaccinations at your Screening appointment.

*** If you need additional immunizations to volunteer for UnityPoint Health Finley Hospital, we are happy to provide these immunizations at Finley Employee Health or Finley Occupational Health at no cost to you. Obtaining these immunizations elsewhere is at your own expense.
