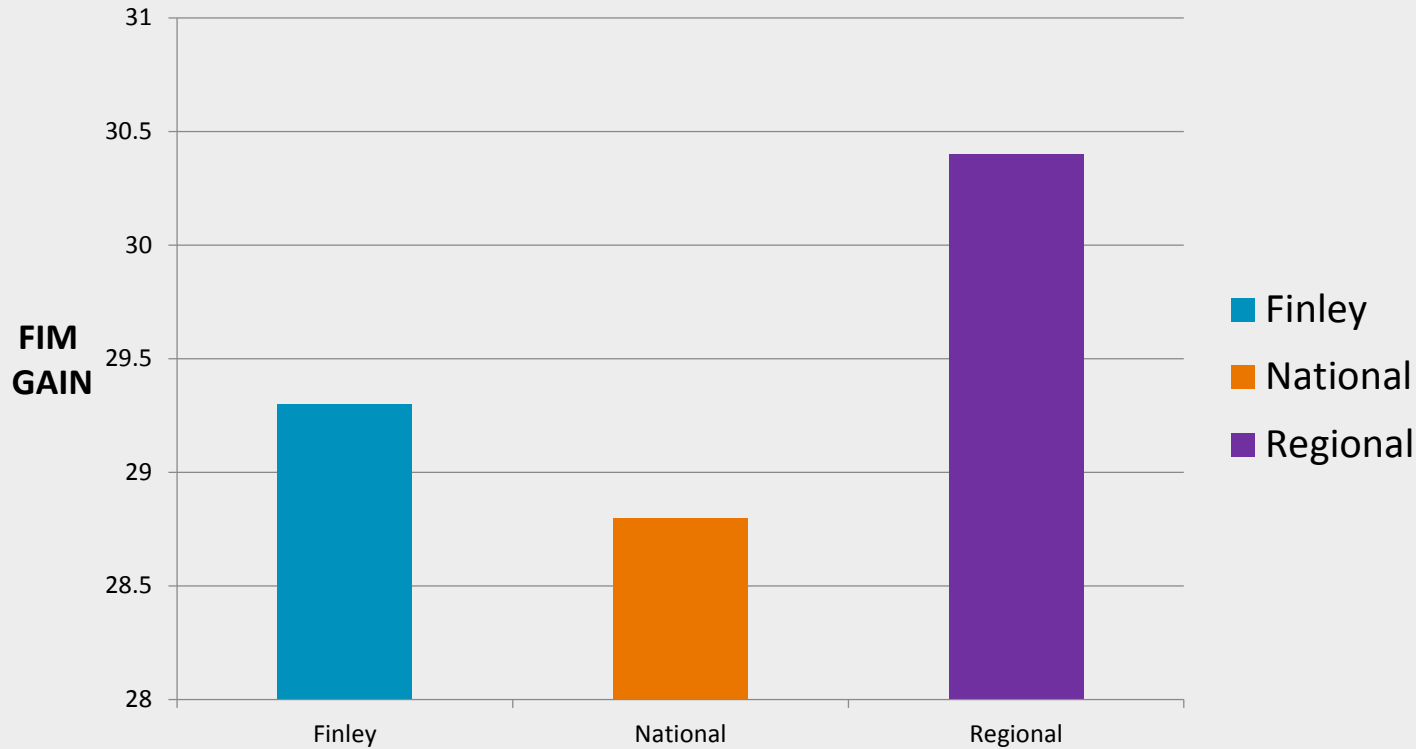


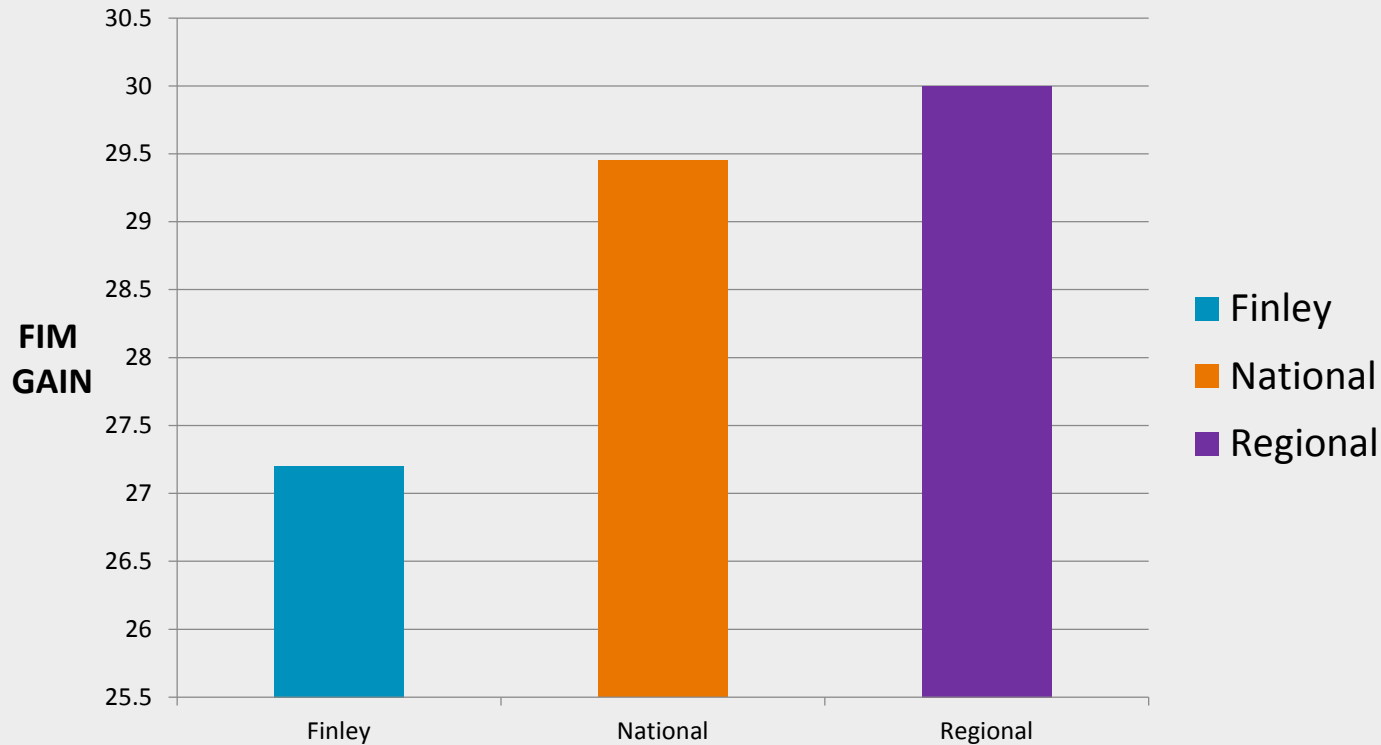
2016 Brain Injury FIM Change

FIM - scoring tool for measuring progress of patient during their rehab stay



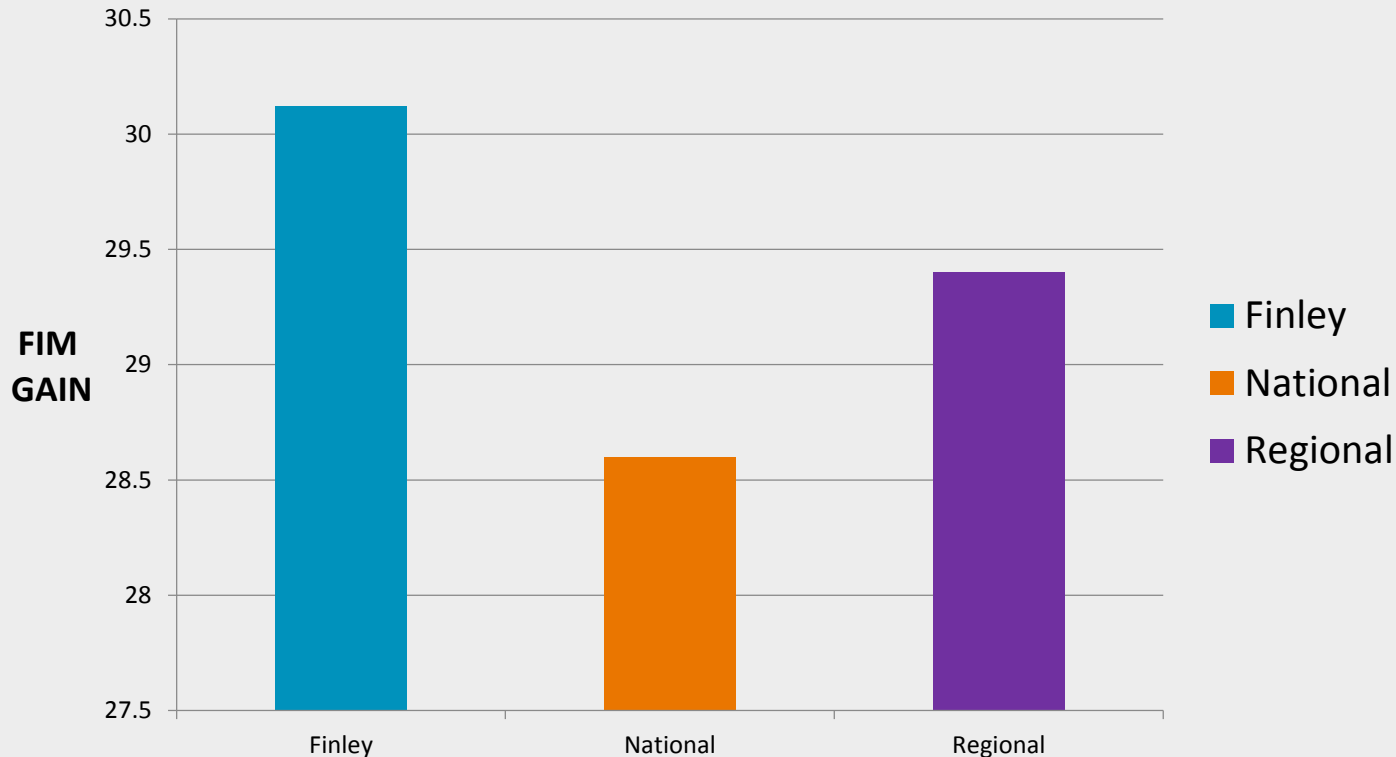

FIM - scoring tool for measuring progress of patient during their rehab stay



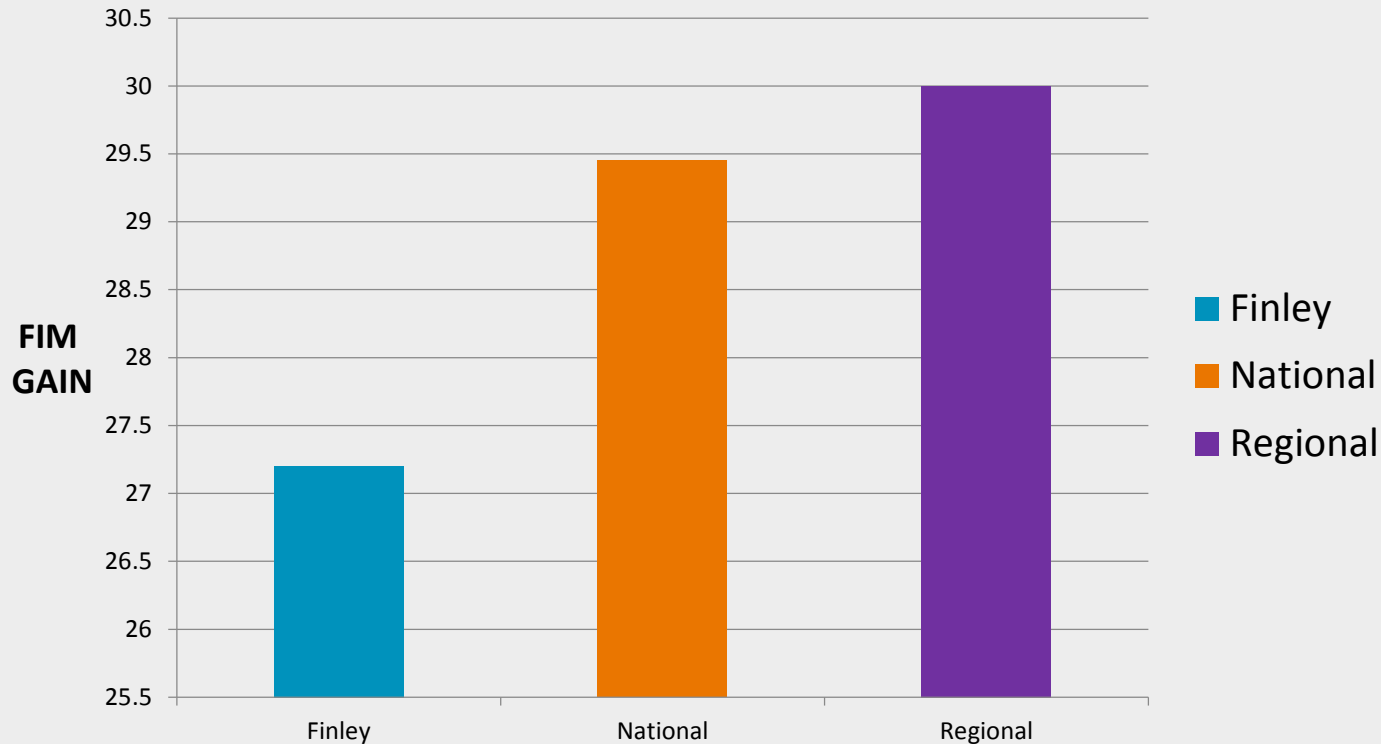
2016 Stroke FIM Change

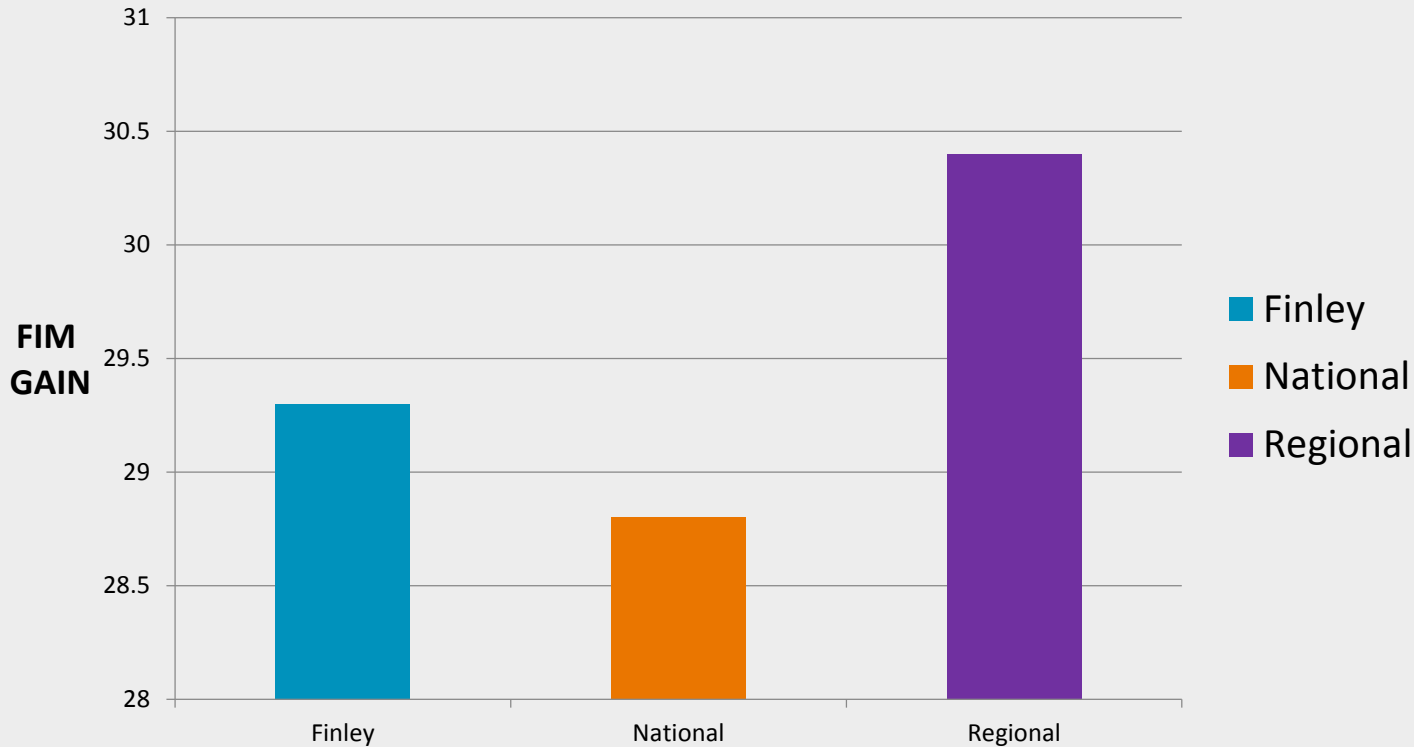

The Functional Independence Measure (FIM). Patients are scored in their level of independence in 18 areas, such as dressing, grooming, and locomotion. Scoring occurs at admission and throughout the course of stay. The program anticipates that the FIM gain for our patients by discharge will be in the range of 26-28 points. Of the 223 patients served in 2015, the overall FIM gain attained was 25.50, above the national average of 23.74
