



Starting Hepatitis C Treatment

Your doctor would like you to start treatment. Now what?

Your doctor's office will work closely with the UnityPoint at Home (UPaH) Specialty Pharmacy and your insurance company to help decide which treatment is best for you.

Lab Work

Before treatment, your doctor's office will set up tests for the following:

- Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, and HIV
- Alcohol and drug screens as requested by your insurance company
- Blood tests to ensure safety and proper dosing
- Other testing to guide what therapy will be used and for how long

Insurance Check

Our pharmacy will check with your insurance company to confirm your coverage. The length of this process varies.

Phone Call

Our pharmacy will contact you. During your first phone call, we will:

- Confirm your address and day of delivery
- Confirm your medicines and allergies
- Talk to you about calls you will receive throughout your treatment

Following your phone call with our pharmacy, the staff will work with your doctor's office to inform your nurse when you should receive your medicines and start therapy.

Final Lab Work

Hepatitis C can be cured and it is very important to take your medicines as directed for your treatment to be successful. Your doctor's office will call you to set up follow up visits and lab tests to monitor your care and confirm successful outcome.
