

RESEARCH PROTOCOL TITLE: All of Us

PRINCIPAL INVESTIGATOR: Beth Burnside, MD UW Madison Institute for Clinical and Translational Research (ICTR)

STUDY PURPOSE

All of Us focuses on precision medicine, seeking to make health care more personalized by using information about an individual's environment, lifestyle and family health history. The Wisconsin team joins nine other states in an effort to gather health information on more than one million people to inform research intended to prevent and treat disease based on the uniqueness of the individual.

RESEARCH PROCEDURES

Participants in the program will be asked to share their electronic health records and answer questions about their health habits and home and work life, have some physical measurements taken, and will be asked to submit samples of blood and urine. Upon completion, each participant receives \$25 and will have online access to their health data with the option to share the information with their health care provider, if they choose to do so.

In time, researchers will have access to this data, which will comprise the largest health database of its kind, to conduct studies, looking for patterns to learn more about what affects people's health.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR SUBJECTS

COMPENSATION/REIMBURSEMENT

Upon completion of 3 questionnaires, measurements and giving blood and urine samples, each participant receives \$25.
