Faith Ambassador Program Mission:

The mission of the *Faith Ambassador Program* is to educate people about ACP in community settings throughout Dane County. To date, the program has presented to more than 1,200 people across groups ranging from faith-based congregations to libraries, civic communities, conferences, veteran groups, nursing homes, radio, television, and more. The *Faith Ambassador Program* received an ACP Community Champion award at HCW’s “Sharing the Experience Conference” in 2015 and was also selected to present the program to the Respecting Choices® first annual “National ACP Conference” in 2016.
