Its purpose is to provide personal and professional development in the delivery of spiritual care through supervised reflection on ministry. It emphasizes collegial support in ministry through the peer group experience of pastoral/spiritual/theological reflection. This program is ideal for parish clergy, seminarians, parish nurses, chaplains, and other interested lay persons.
