<p>1. Routine patient care.</p> <p>2. Make sure law enforcement is informed of destination, do not delay transport to wait for law enforcement.</p> <p>3. Do not disturb crime scene.</p> <p>4. Do not assess genital area unless absolutely necessary.</p> <p>4. If clothing is removed for assessment purposes, make sure all clothing and personal belongings go into a paper bag.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Paper bag must include:</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">Run number</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">Date and time of placement of article(s)</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">Your name</p> <p>5.
