The DAISY Award For Extraordinary Nurses

Purpose: The DAISY Award is designed to recognize a nurse's compassionate care and clinical skills that exemplifies the kind of nurse that our patients, their families, and our staff recognize as an outstanding role model.

Instructions: Please complete nomination on a separate form including sharing a story as to how your nominee demonstrates the following criteria.

- Serves as a role model for the CARE values;
- Serves as a role model for the nursing profession;
- Is an exceptional team player;
- Established an extraordinary professional connection with patients and families;
- Uses critical thinking skills in the delivery of extraordinary care;
- Demonstrates professionalism in the work environment;
- Is a colleague in good standing;
- Demonstrates respect and excellent interpersonal skills with peers, physicians, and co-workers.

Examples of “nursing excellence” include, but are not limited to the following:
